

POST SAL ACTIVITIES FOR SCHEDULE COORDINATION / FACILITATION AT AUSTRIAN AIRPORTS

Background

More and more airlines are requesting coordinators / facilitators to handle scheduling activities during the period between the distribution of SALs and the start of the relevant IATA Scheduling Conference.

Also the Worldwide Slot Guidelines support of these activities.

SCA Schedule Coordination Austria (SCA), the designated Coordinator/Facilitator for the airports Graz, Innsbruck, Klagenfurt, Linz, Salzburg and Vienna developed this document to establish a transparent, neutral and non-discriminatory process of activities before the start of the relevant IATA Scheduling Conference.

Post SAL-Activities are aiming to reduce unnecessary workload at the Scheduling Conferences and to improve its efficiency. The scope, however, is limited and shall not include discussions about airline strategies or operational plans, suggestions for schedule improvements, new slot requests, significant changes to allocated slot timings or significant changes in aircraft capacity.

Publication of SALs

- SCA Schedule Coordination Austria will distribute the SAL messages for the airports in Austria as soon as possible after the initial submission deadline, latest at the day of the SAL deadline published by IATA.
- The complete schedule database for each of the Austrian Airports is available to all airlines that submitted a SCR/SMA for that airport. This information is available either upon request (SIR) or via OCS or e-Airportslots.

Procedures for post SAL Activities

- Post SAL activities will be accepted as from the first working day after the distribution of the SAL.
- Post SAL activities will be accepted until the last Friday before the start of the IATA SC, 12:00 hours local time Vienna.



- Additionally SCA may enter into post SAL activities with any airline regarding their schedule requirements, as stated in section 9.10. of latest edition of IATA WSG.
- Airlines may seek schedule improvements, request new slots, and make changes to allocated slots. Slots may also be exchanged or transferred between airlines, subject to the provisions of 8.12. and 8.13. In particular, the acceptance of offers and cancellation of unwanted slots is encouraged in order to improve the efficiency of the SC.
- At those <u>schedules facilitated</u> airports in Austria, where there are no congestion problems, all types of schedule changes are permitted during this post SAL period.
