3. Coordination / Facilitation principles:

3.1. Flights to be coordinated:

- 3.1.1. In accordance with the amended EU-Regulation 95/93 and Regulation 155/2008 issued by the Ministry of Transport, Innovation & Technology of Austria all flights operating under IFR rules have to be coordinated on days 6 and 7 during the winter season and on 02/09JAN (in case they are neither Saturday nor Sunday).
- 3.1.2. VFR flights have to respect the PPR procedure applicable at Innsbruck Airport.
- 3.1.3. Slots for positioning flights (service type "P") may be requested after the "Historics Baseline Date" of the relevant season earliest.
- 3.1.4. Slots for technical flights (service type "T"), for training flights (service type "K") or technical stops (service type "X") may be requested 28 days ahead of the planned operation earliest.
- 3.1.5. Slots for GA/BA flights for days 6 and 7 during the winter season and on 02/09JAN (in case they are neither Saturday nor Sunday) with service type "D", "N" or "P" may be requested 28 days ahead of the planned operation earliest; latest 1 hour before the planned operation.
- 3.1.6. All operators are informed, that due to capacity constraints ground-time and parking of aircraft might be limited. See also Notams for INN Airport.
- 3.1.7. Slots for governmental flights (service type "E"); ambulance -, rescue - or humanitarian flights (service type "U"); state - or diplomatic flights (service type "I") and military flights (service type "W") will not be proved against the capacity limits.
- 3.1.8. Requests for single operations or series of flights which do not create a recognizable period will not be accepted before the "Historics Baseline Date" (31. August).

- 3.1.9. All Operators are informed, that due to capacity constraints parking of aircraft might be limited and operators might be requested to depart the aircraft to other stations.
- 3.1.10. See also "Local Guidelines" available on www.slots-austria.com.

3.2. Flights to be facilitated:

During the whole summer season and on days 1-5 during the winter season Innsbruck Airport (except 02/09 JAN in case they are neither Saturday nor Sunday) is handled as facilitated airport (SMA).

3.3. No Cargo Flights:

- 3.3.1 Due to infrastructural constraints it is not possible to handle pure cargo flights at Innsbruck Airport.

4. Submission of slot requests / schedule requests:

- 4.1. Schedule and slot requests for scheduled and charter flights have to be sent in SSIM Chapter 6 format either by
- e-mail to vipecpxh@slots-austria.com with a copy to INN Airport (slots@innsbruck-airport.com) or
 - OCS (Online Coordination System).
- 4.2. Slot requests for GA/BA flights (see 3.1.5. and 3.1.6.) on days 6 and 7 during winter season and on 02/09JAN (in case they are neither Saturday nor Sunday) have to be requested at
- the Operations Office of Innsbruck Airport by email (slot.gac@innsbruck-airport.com) or
 - the GA/BA Handling Agent at Innsbruck Airport or
 - via OCS (Online Coordination System)
- 4.3. Due to terminal constraints and strict noise-restrictions it is required that all operators state the exact number of seats and aircraft subtype codes in all SCRs and SMAs.

5. Minimum Ground Times (MGT):

- 5.1. Minimum ground times have to be cleared and confirmed with Innsbruck Airport (ops@innsbruck-airport.com).
- 5.2. Handling requests have to be cleared and confirmed with the handling agents available at Innsbruck Airport.
- 5.3. The following table should give you an indication of the minimum ground times at Innsbruck Airport:

AC-size	MGT in Minutes
Up to 80 seats	20 – 30
Up to 110 seats	45
Up to 190 seats	50
More than 190 seats	60
